- Assist with inventory control audits
- Receive and enter in-kind donations, when necessary
- Work closely with volunteers, including delegating tasks
- Assist with the operations and inventory management of food drives
- Stocking of satellite pantry locations as needed
- Special projects and opportunities as needed
